



CAMP GROUND GUIDELINES

Observing the following guidelines while camping with us will help everyone to have a safe and enjoyable time. If you have any questions please reach out to the Welcome Center. We'd be happy to help you!

- ❖ Quiet time is from 11:00pm to 7:00am.
- ❖ The speed limit in the park is 5mph for vehicles and golf carts.
- ❖ All power-driven vehicles and bikes should only be driven on roadways, trails and open fields.
- ❖ Pedestrians have the right of way on all roadways, trails and open fields.
- ❖ We ask that only licensed drivers operate motor vehicles on Warner Camp property.
- ❖ No bikes, scooters, roller blades etc. should be ridden in the main campus commons area (near the tabernacle, bathrooms and leather shop) This is for the safety of all guests.
- ❖ Campfires should only be in approved containers and attended to at all times.
- ❖ Please do not burn trash and do not put fire ashes in dumpsters. 🔥🔥🔥
- ❖ Along with a trailer, each lot may have 1 sleeping tent and 1 screen tent.
- ❖ Only 1 vehicle per lot. Other vehicles should be parked in the designated parking area near the entrance of the RV Park.
- ❖ Camping units/trailers shall be clean and well cared for. Please maintain a 4-foot clearance around all boundaries (as per the Michigan DEQ)
- ❖ Boat or utility trailers should not be stored on lots. They can be stored in the designated storage area. If you need assistance with locating a space to store your boat or utility trailer, please contact the Welcome Center.
- ❖ All other times, pets should be kept on a leash. Please clean up after your pet promptly.
- ❖ Swimming is at your own risk. Parents are responsible for their children at all times.
- ❖ Fishing is allowed on designated fishing piers only. A fish cleaning station is available behind the west campground restroom. Please place remains in a plastic bag and dispose in the dumpster.
- ❖ Warner Camp is a tobacco, firearms, and alcohol-free campus.
- ❖ Ice and wood are sold at the Welcome Center.
- ❖ Boat rental, high ropes course, rock wall and zip line paid time are available during designated times, at the Welcome Center.
- ❖ Please sign up for RV pumps outs 24 hours in advance in the Welcome Center. \$25 per pump out - \$45 for emergency pump outs.
